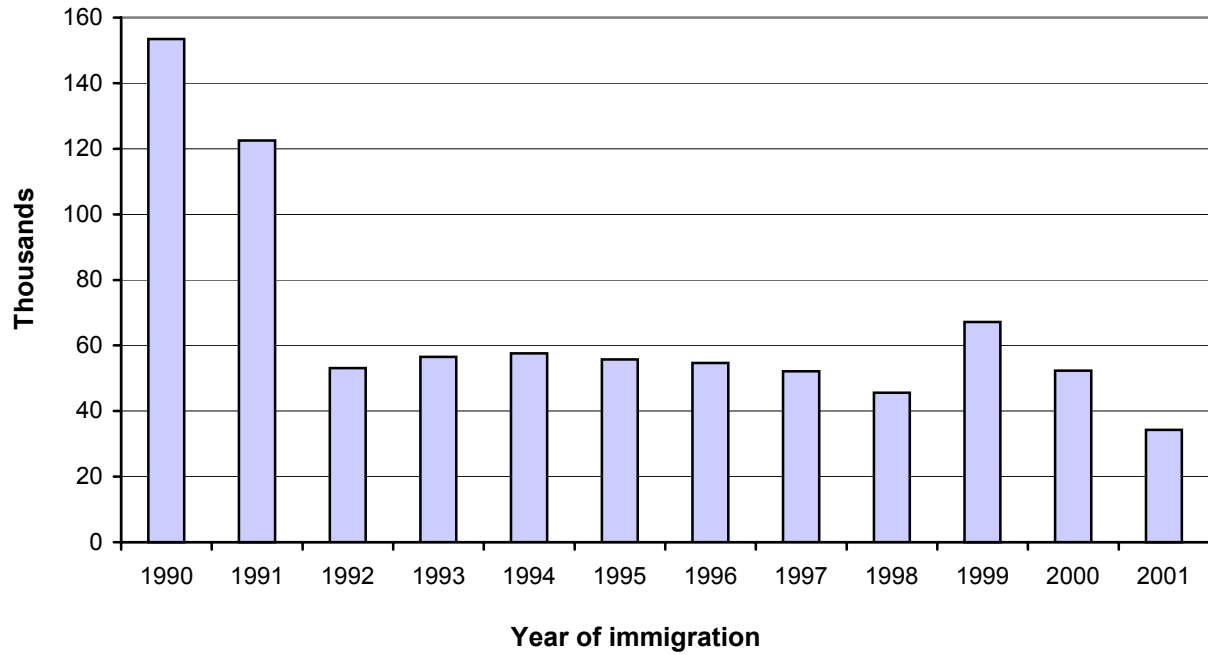
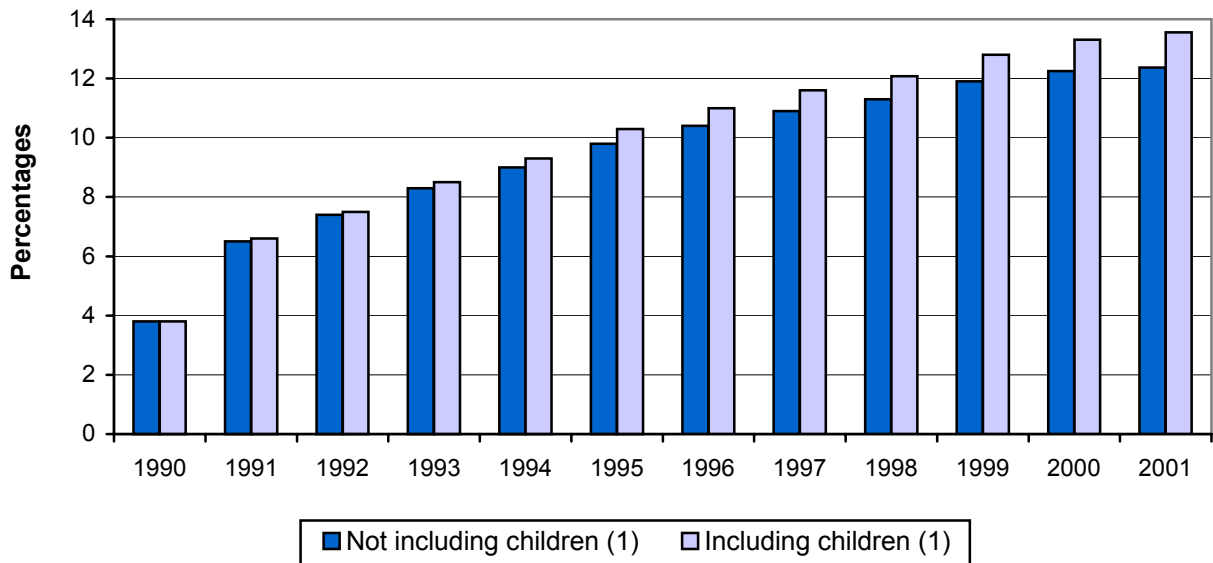


**DIAGRAM 1.- IMMIGRANT POPULATION FROM THE FORMER USSR,

End of 2001**

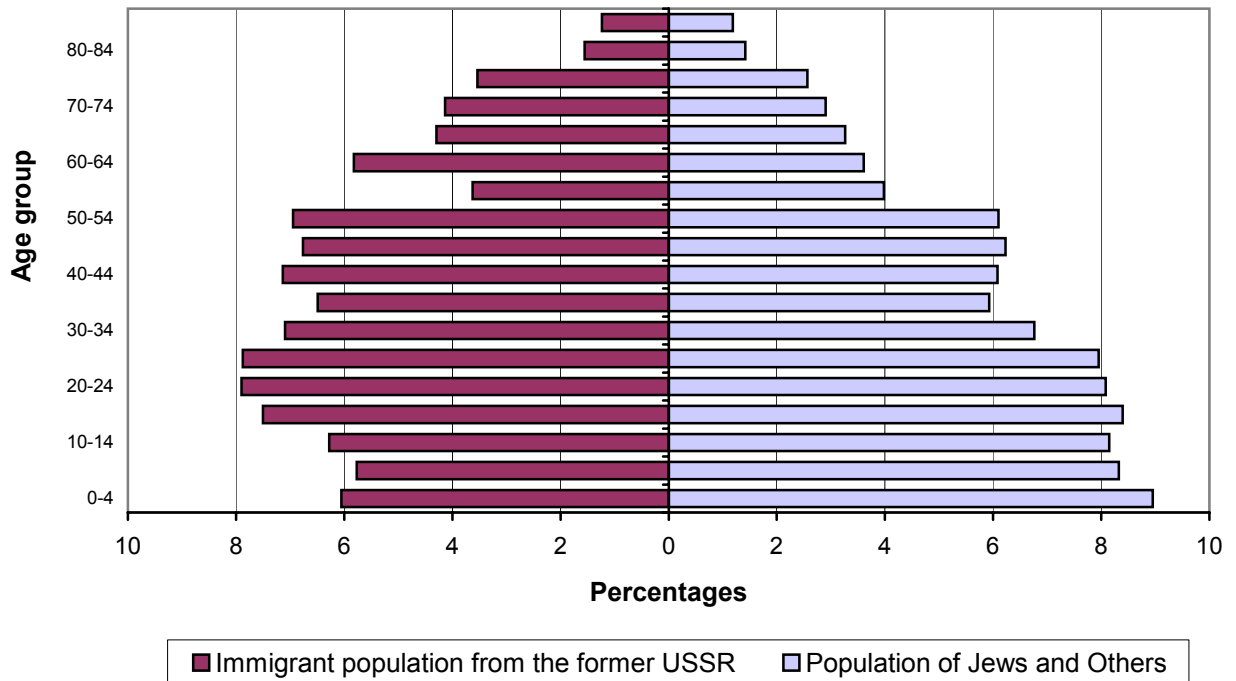


**DIAGRAM 2.- IMMIGRANT POPULATION FROM THE FORMER USSR,

1990-2001**

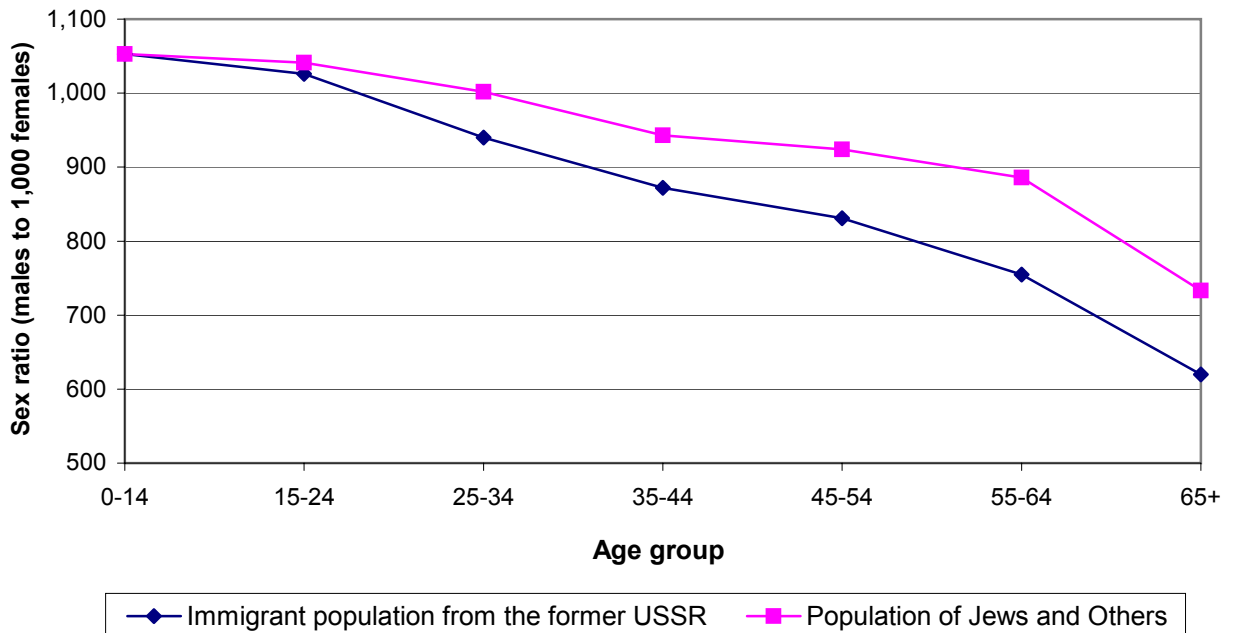

2001**

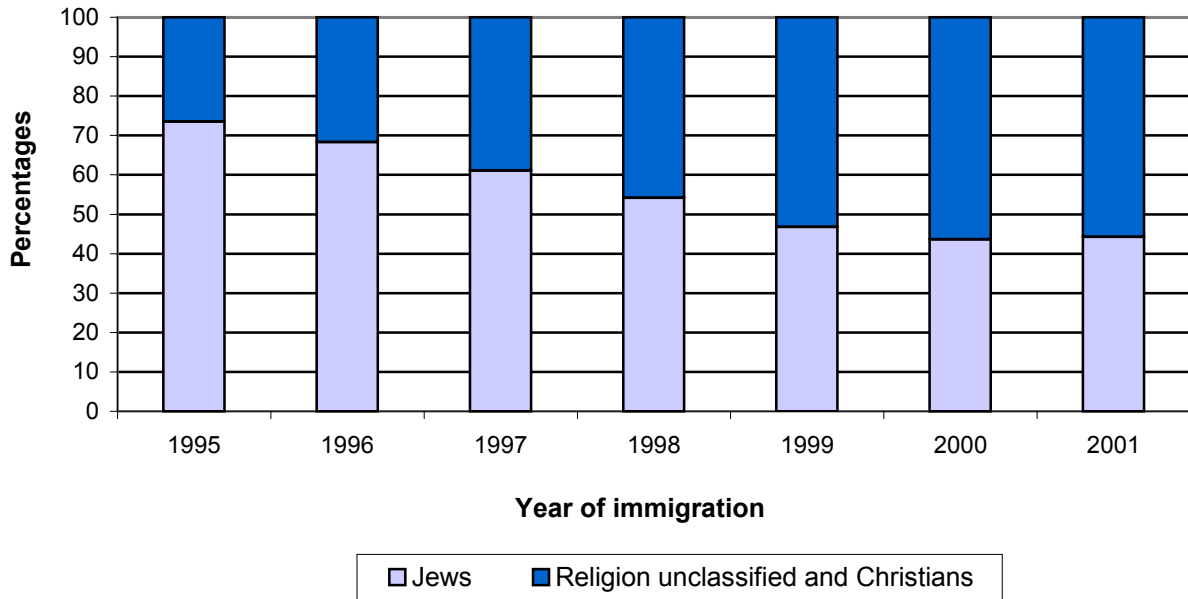


**DIAGRAM 4.- SEX RATIO AMONG IMMIGRANT POPULATION FROM THE

2001**

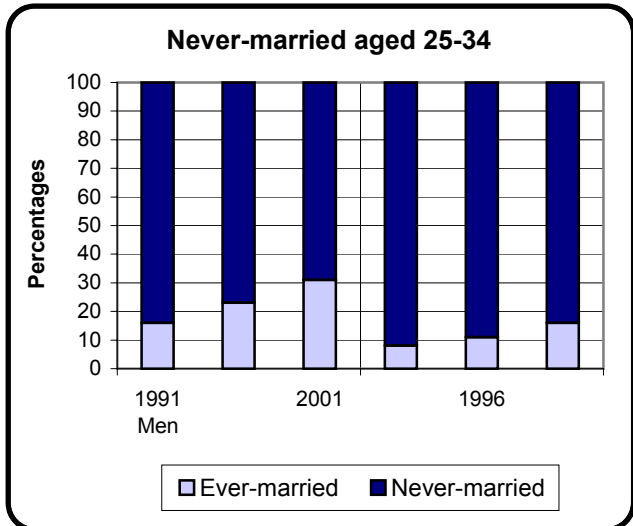
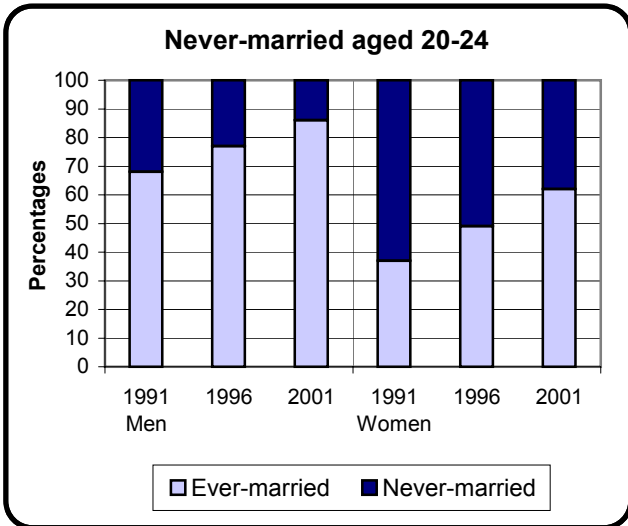

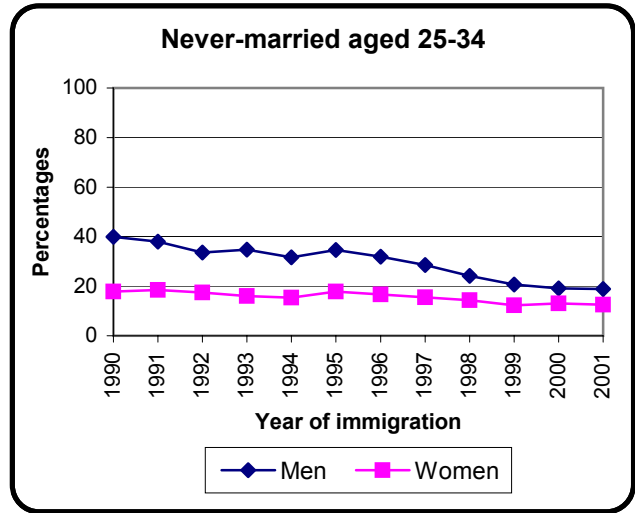
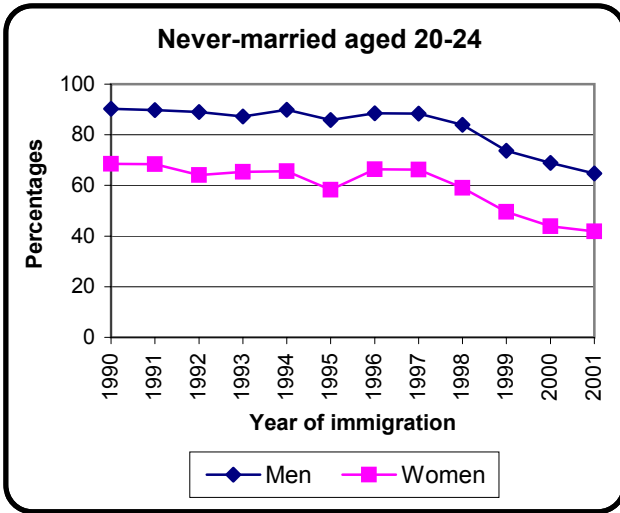

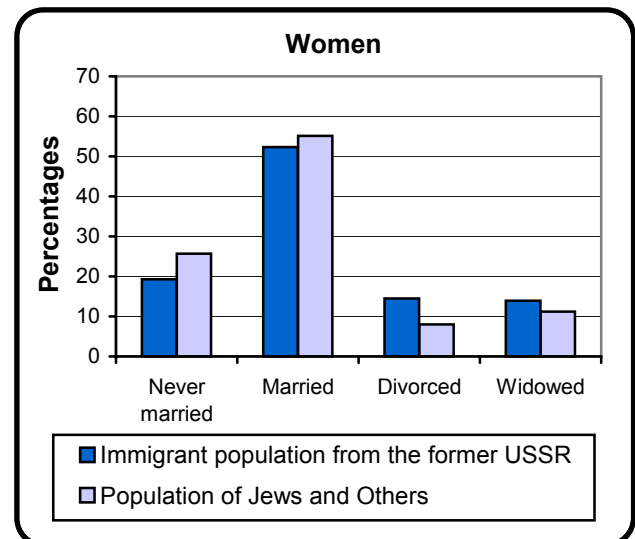
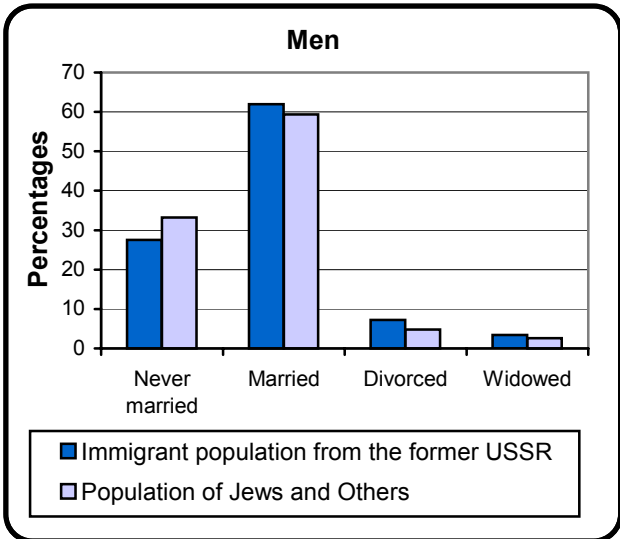

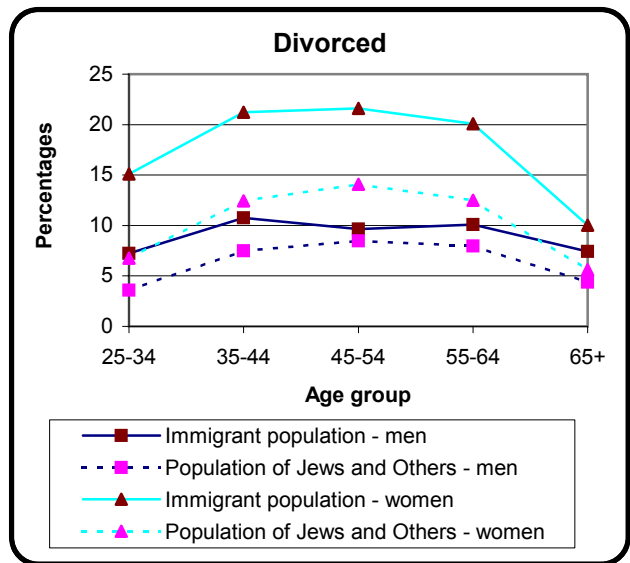
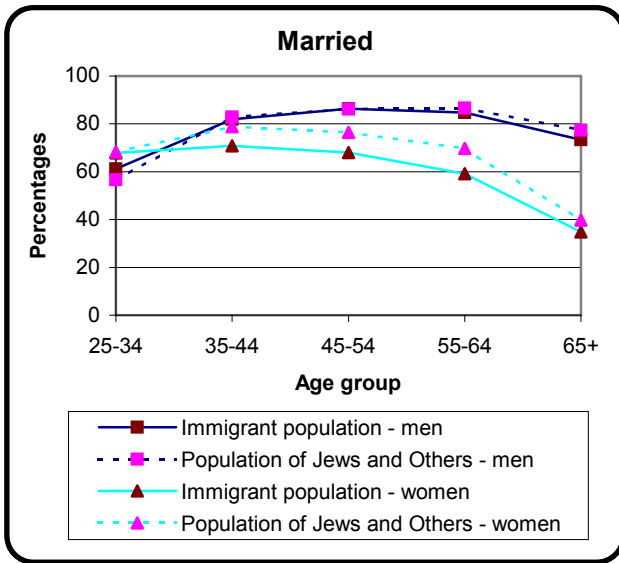

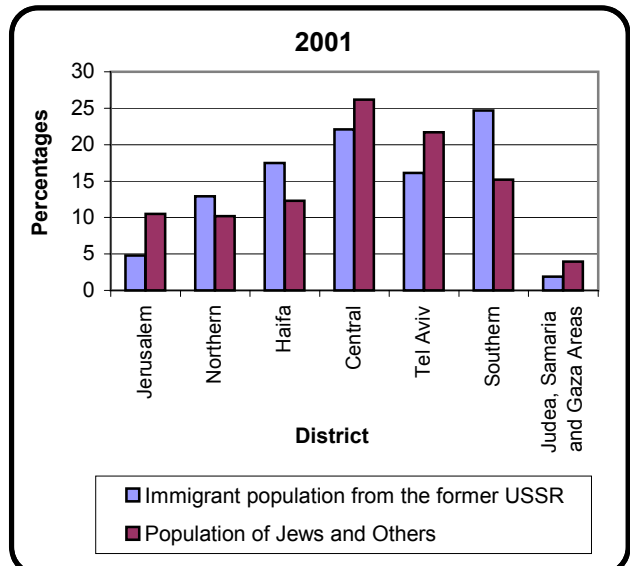
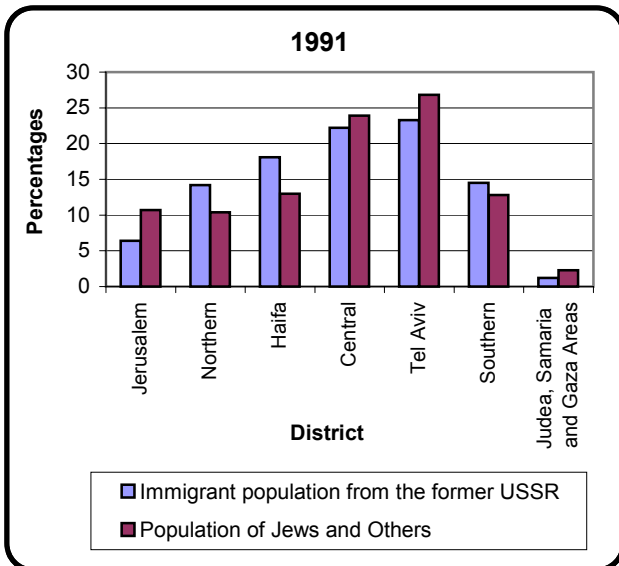

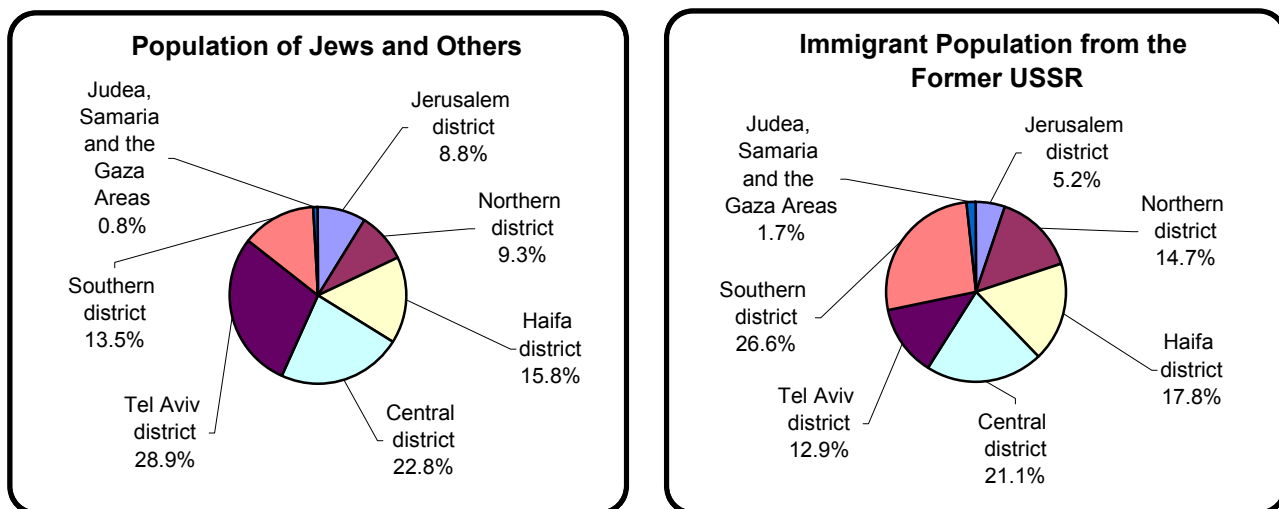

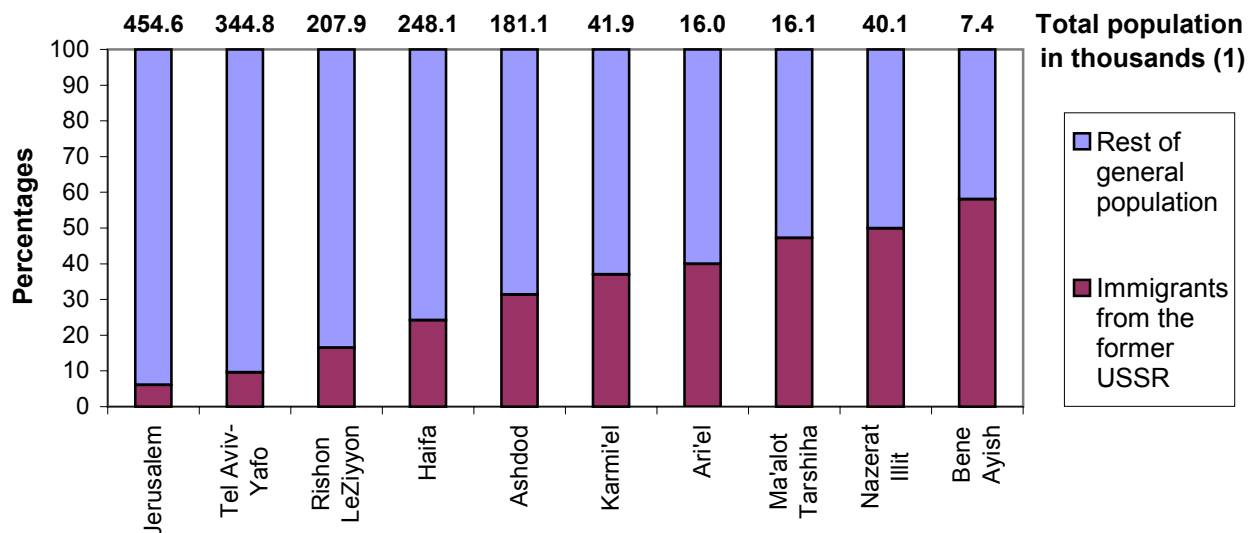

2001**

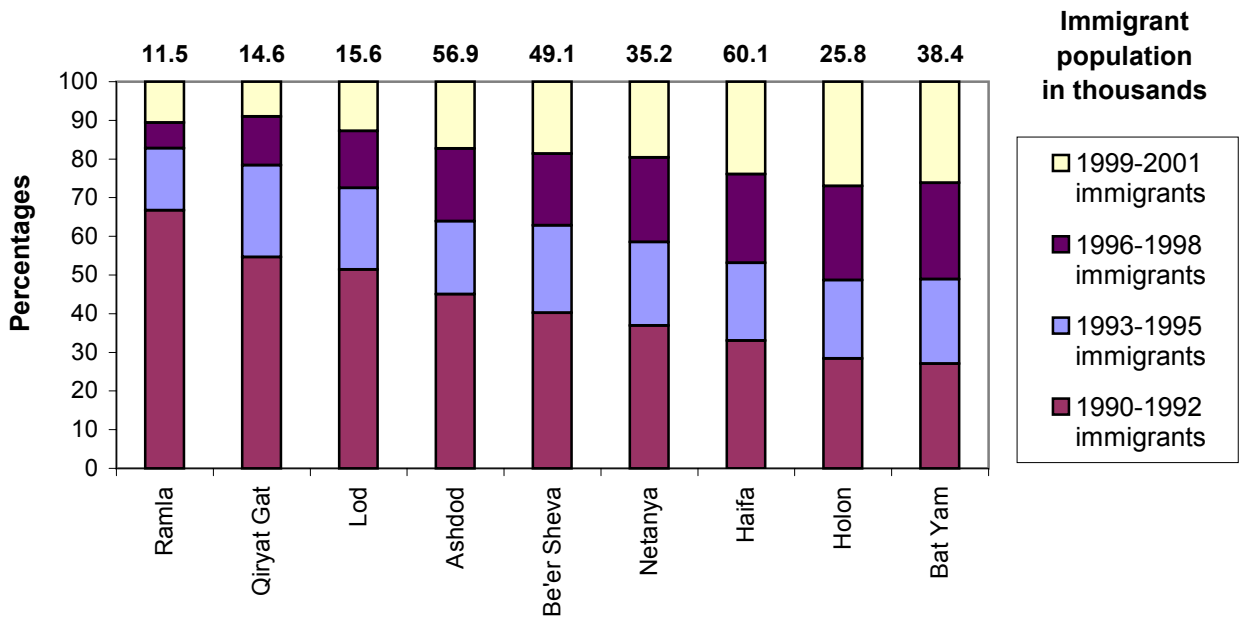


**DIAGRAM 12.- IMMIGRANT POPULATION FROM THE FORMER USSR, BY SELECTED LOCALITIES  
2001**

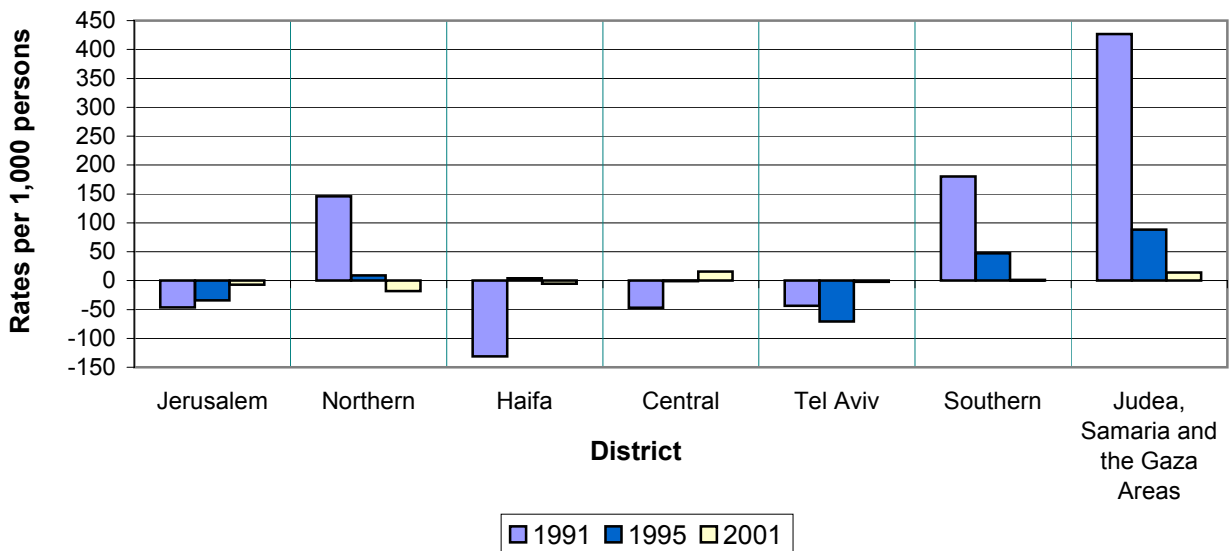

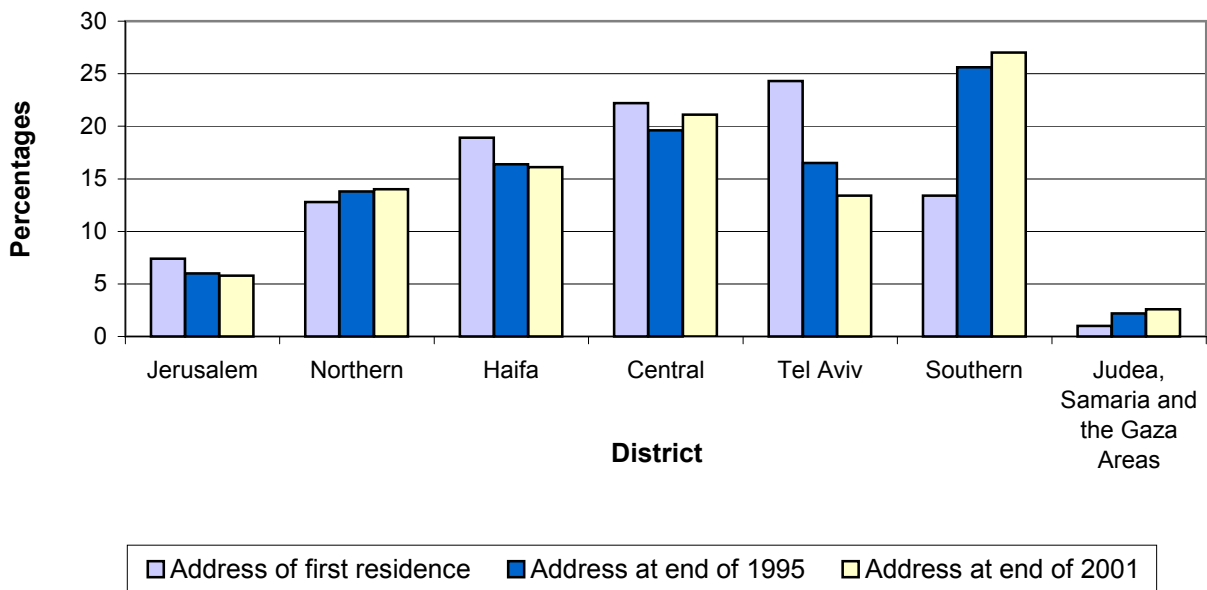
**DIAGRAM 13.- IMMIGRANT POPULATION FROM THE FORMER USSR,

2001**



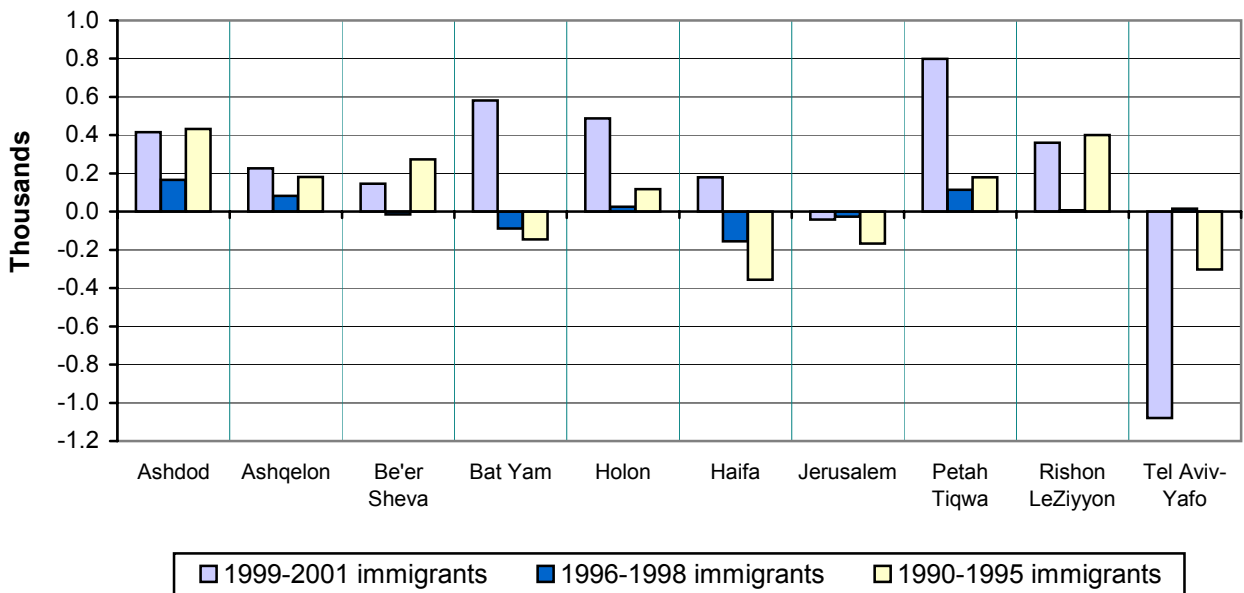
**DIAGRAM 14.- MIGRATION BALANCE OF THE IMMIGRANT POPULATION  
FROM THE FORMER USSR, BY DISTRICT IN SELECTED YEARS**



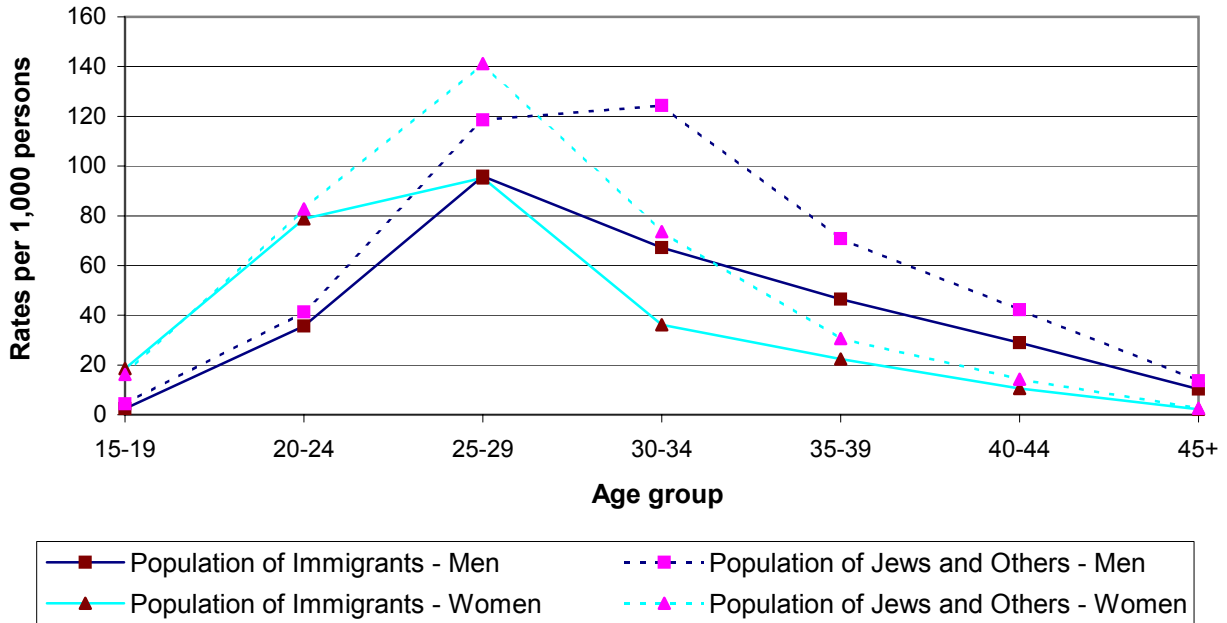

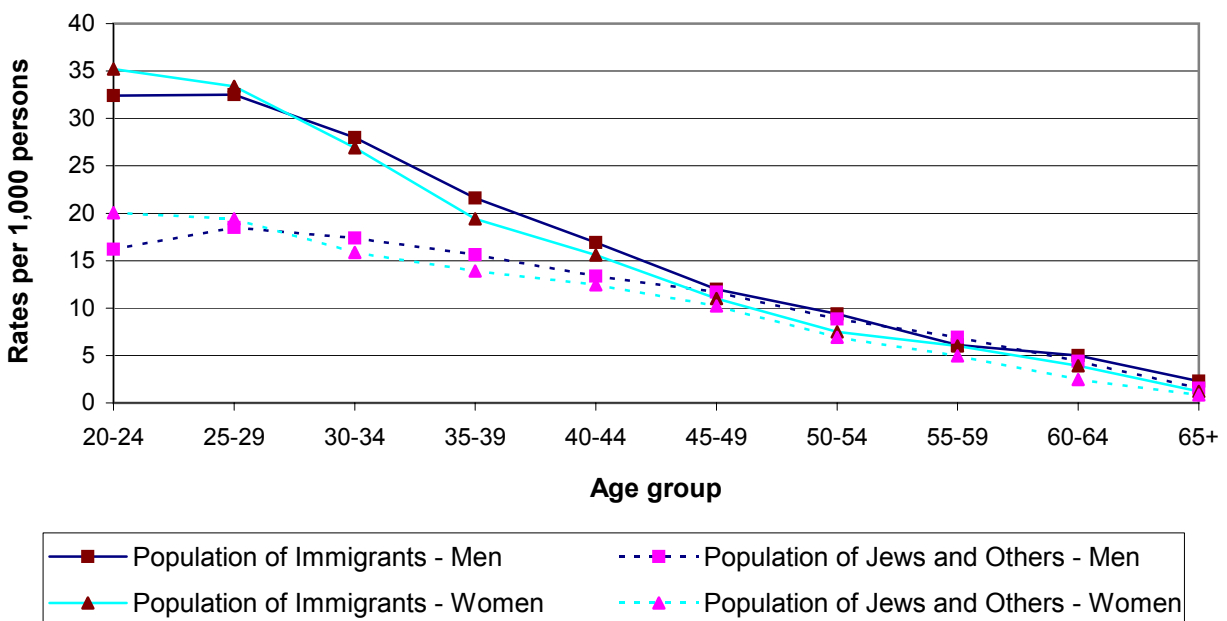

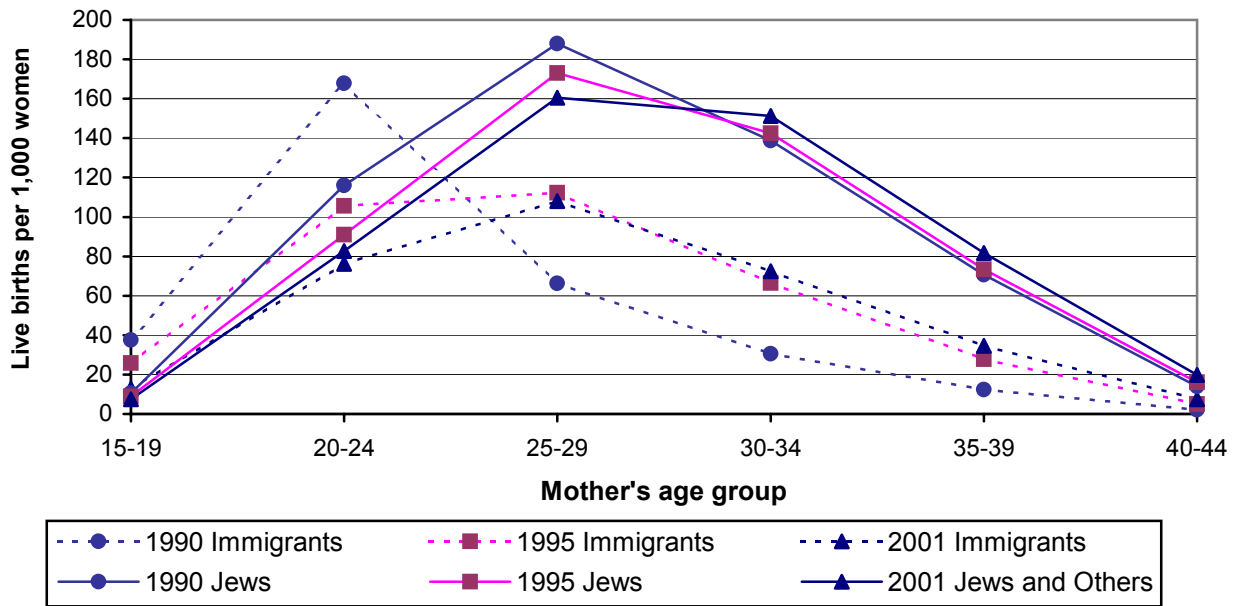

2001**

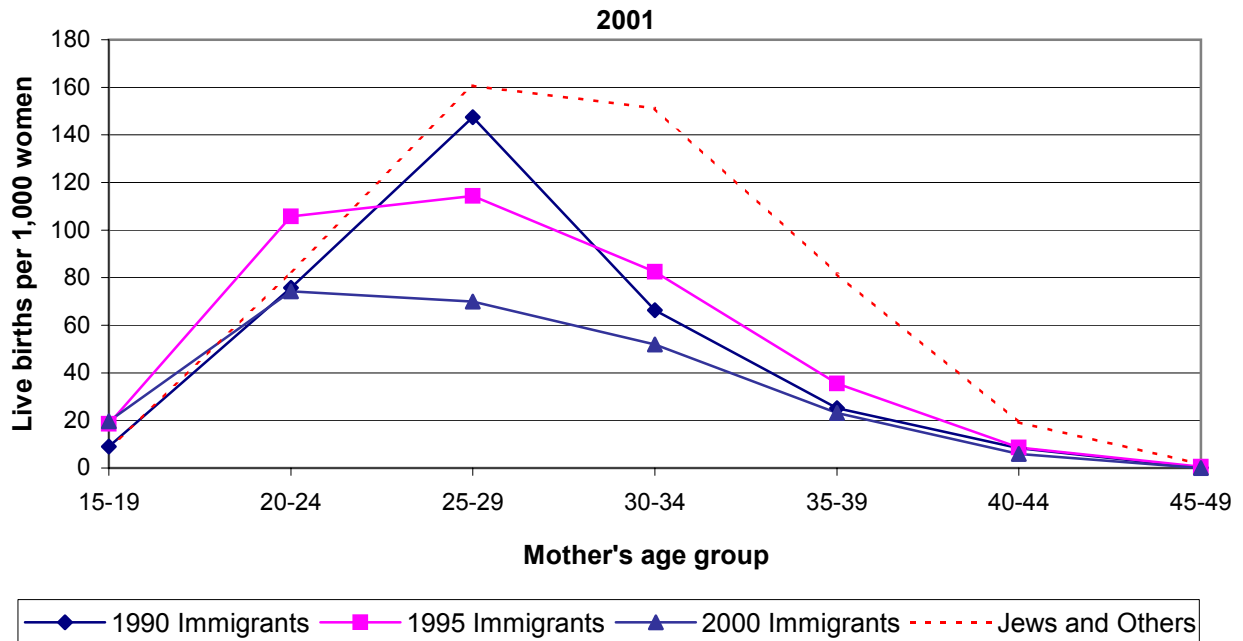

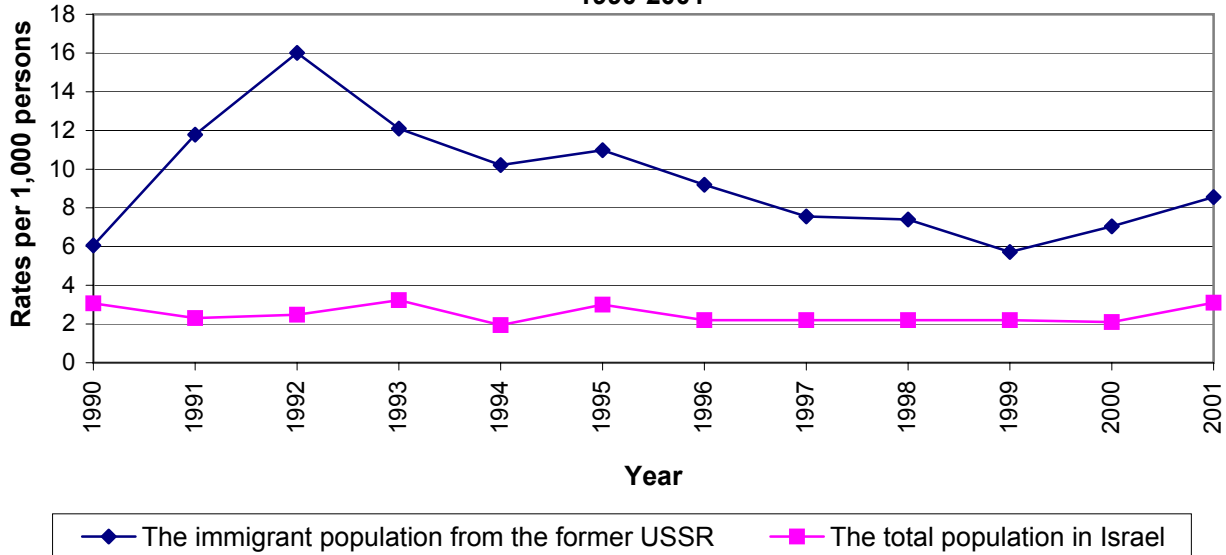
