

A newsletter published within the European Union's ENPI programme for Israel **EU Twinning Project: Support to the Israeli Central Bureau of Statistics**



The EU Twinning project with the Israeli Central Bureau of Statistics held its Closing Ceremony on 17 December 2014 in the Bible Lands Museum of Jerusalem, and celebrated its results with partners of the National Statistical System as well as with users of statistics.

More than 100 people took part in the event which marked the successful fulfillment of the project's objective to improve the quality and comparability of Israeli official statistics.

The Government Statistician, professor Danny Pfeffermann, opened the Closing Ceremony by stressing the very strong influence of the project which had been felt throughout the whole organization during the implementation period.

The Head of the EU Delegation to Israel, Lars Faaborg-Andersen congratulated both partners, the Israeli Central Bureau of Statistics (ICBS) and Statistics Denmark, on the implementation and the results achieved. He emphasized the importance of having reliable statistics available for policy and decision making.

The project leader from Statistics Denmark, Lars Thygesen, focused on the particular nature of this Twinning project having inspirational discussions at a very advanced level, for the benefit of EU experts as well as for the Israeli experts in development of their daily work.

The project leader from ICBS, Olivia Blum who was the Chair of the event, read a letter of congratulations from Claudia Junker, Head of Eurostat's

Statistical Cooperation Unit and compared the project's focus on establishing an Israeli National Statistical System (NSS) with the similar steps being taken in EU these years.

The project's RTA, Thomas Bie, gave an overview of the results achieved, and Batia Attali, the RTA counterpart, described the mode of action and the value of the Twinning partnership in a philosophical manner.

The users' perspective was brought by Dr. Shirley Avrami, director of Research and Information Center in the Knesst, the Center's use of spoke about statistics as one of the cornerstones in serving the information needs of all Knesset members as well as the public at large.

The Bank of Israel (Bol) is, as a producers of official statistics, one of ICBS's main partners in the National Statistical System. Bol has played a part in several of the project's components, and Tzahi Frankovits, director of Statistics and Information Department in the Bol, mentioned in his speach the first-ever inclusion of statistics in Bol's annual work programme. This new status of statistics was brought about by the Twinning project and the work on the National Statistical System..

The Associate Government Statistician, Yoel Finkel, concluded the event by referring to the importance of the Twinning project to the coordination within ICBS, and between ICBS and its partners in the NSS. The commitment of ICBS staff to reach the goals according to the project timetable was a key factor to its success.
