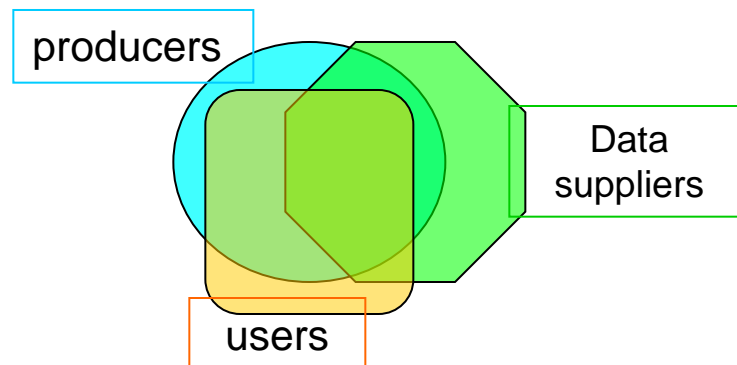

The National Statistical System is-

The ensemble of statistical organizations and units within a country that jointly collect, process and disseminate official statistics on behalf of national government

The Arena

- **Users of statistics:** Public sector, private sector, businesses, researchers, public at large and the international organizations.
- **Data suppliers:** Households, businesses and holders of administrative records.
- **Statistics compilers/providers:** National and global actors in different statistical systems.



Recognition and Acknowledgement

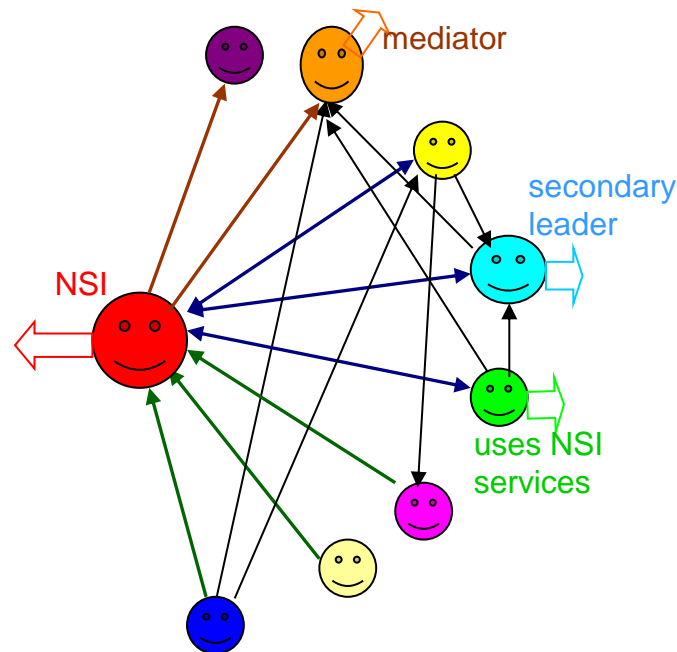
- The idea of a NSS as a system is relatively new and it is a result of the information and technology era, and of global management and production processes;
- In the Statistics Ordinance of Israel: **State agencies** performing statistical acts;
- In the Twinning Project: For the 1st time addressing our partners in the NSS as colleagues in the same **system**.

Twining Activities, By-products, Results

- Interactions with partners;
- Presentation of activities and products;
- Learning about producers needs;
- Focus groups with users;
- MoU became a buzz word and discussions have started;
- The new Public Council for Statistics, headed by the new Chair, is acting to fulfill its role as a coordinator of the statistical activities (of the State bodies);
- The State Comptroller and the State Control Committee of the Knesset expresses the need and the obligation of ICBS and PCS to plan and work on an NSS level.
