Labour Force Survey Data, July 2019

Seasonally Adjusted Data¹

In July 2019 (compared with June 2019): (For monthly data 6/2019)

- Unemployment rate among persons aged 15 and over from the labour force 3.7% (4.1% in the previous month).
- Participation rate in the labour force among persons aged 15 and over 63.1% (63.4% in the previous month).
- Employment rate (the percentage of employed persons out of the total population) among persons aged 15 and over 60.8% (same as in the previous month).
- Unemployment rate among persons aged 25-64 from the labour force 3.3% (3.4% in the previous month).
- Participation rate in the labour force among persons aged 25-64 79.6% (80.3% in the previous month).
- Employment rate among persons aged 25-64 77.0% (77.5% in the previous month).
- The share of employed persons usually working full time out of total employed persons 78.5% (78.3% in the previous month).

Definitions and Explanations


The Labour Force Survey is the main source of information regarding the labour force in Israel, and is conducted by the Central Bureau of Statistics on an ongoing basis. Starting from the beginning of 2019, an average of 20,100 persons aged 15 and over a month have been

interviewed on an ongoing basis. The survey population includes the permanent population of Israel, as well as tourists and temporary residents living in Israel continuously for more than one year. The survey follows the development of the labour force in Israel, its size and characteristics, the extent of unemployment, etc.

July 2019 (compared with June 2019) - Seasonally Adjusted Data


Persons aged 15 and over



In July 2019, **the number of persons in the labour force** aged 15 and over was 4.101 million. Among them, 3.951 million were **employed** and approximately 150,000 were **unemployed**. Among the employed persons, 2.071 million were **men** (2.062 million in the previous month) and 1.880 million were **women** (1.886 million in the previous month).

The participation rate among persons aged 15 and over **in the labour force** declined to 63.1% (63.4% in the previous month). Among **men**, that rate declined to 67.4% (67.8% in the previous month), and among **women** it declined to 59.0% (59.3% in the previous month).

The unemployment rate among persons aged 15 and over **from the labour force** declined to 3.7% (4.1% in the previous month, see diagram 1). The unemployment rate of **men** declined to 3.5% (4.2% in the previous month), and that of **women** declined to 3.9% (4.0% in the previous month).



The employment rate (calculated as the percentage of employed persons out of the total population) among persons aged 15 and over reached 60.8% in July 2019 (same as in the previous month). The employment rate among **men** rose to 65.1% (65.0% in the previous month), whereas among **women** that rate declined 56.7% (56.9% in the previous month).

The number of **employed persons** in July 2019 reached 3.951 million, an increase of 0.1% compared with the previous month. The number of employed persons who **usually work full time** (35 hours and over per week) increased by 0.7% compared with the previous month (an addition of approximately 21,000 employed persons), whereas the number of employed persons who **usually work part time** (less than 35 hours per week) decreased by 0.3% compared with the previous month (a decrease of 3,000 employed persons). The percentage of those who **usually work full time** of all employed persons rose to 78.5% (78.3% in the previous month). Among **men** it reached to 86.8% (same as in the previous month), and among **women** it rose to 69.3% (69.1% in the previous month).

The number of employed persons who **worked full time** (35 hours and over) **in the determinant week** increased by 3.0%, compared with the previous month (an addition of approximately 76,000 employed persons), whereas the number of employed persons who **worked part time** (less than

35 hours) in the determinant week decreased by 5.7% compared with the previous month (a decrease of approximately 63,000 employed persons). The number of employed persons temporarily absent from work in the determinant week decreased by 12.5% compared with the previous month (a decrease of approximately 42,000 employed persons).

Persons aged 25-64

Among persons aged 25-64 **the participation rate in the labour force** declined to 79.6% in July 2019 (80.3% in the previous month). Among **men** that rate declined to 83.7% (84.6% in the previous month), and among **women** that rate declined to 75.6% (76.1% in the previous month).

Among persons aged 25-64 **the unemployment rate from the labour force** declined to 3.3% in this month (3.4% in the previous month). Among **men** the unemployment rate declined to 3.2% (3.5% in the previous month), whereas among **women** that rate reached 3.3% (same as in the previous month).

Among persons aged 25-64 **the employment rate** declined to 77.0% (77.5% in the previous month). Among **men** the employment rate declined to 81.0% (81.6% in the previous month), and among **women** that rate declined to 73.1% (73.6% in the previous month).
